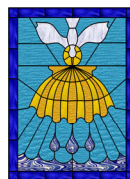

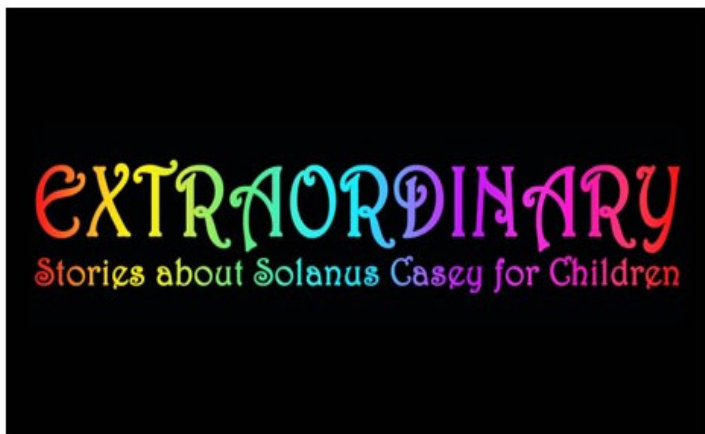

Meditations of the Day

“Preparing for the Day of Judgement”

St. Catherine of Siena

(Doctor of the Church – Stigmatist – Papal Counselor)

“Oh how blessed will my soul be when I see you and the others running like people in love, to give your lives, never turning back! I beg you then for love of Christ crucified to open your mind’s eye now, so that you may be strengthened when his time comes. For I don’t see how you can have this sort of strength, a strength whose source is the gentle mother charity, unless you keep this eye of self-knowledge open always.

“Self-knowledge is the dwelling in which we discover our own lowliness, and this makes us humble. There we find the knowledge of God’s goodness too, and in this light a warmth, a fire of love, is born in us—so gently that all bitterness becomes sweet, everything weak grows strong, and all the ice of selfish love melts away. Then we no longer love ourselves selfishly, but for God. And more, we pour out a river of tears and spread our loving desires out over all our sisters and brothers, loving them with a pure love, without self-interest. And we love God for God’s sake, because He is supreme eternal Goodness, worthy of being loved...

“Let’s not put off any longer our move into this holy dwelling of self-knowledge. We so need this, and it is so pleasant for us—because, as I have said, God’s boundless infinite goodness is there. This then is the weapon I want us to take up...

“I’ll say no more. Keep living in God’s holy and tender love. Gentle Jesus! Jesus!”

“Following Him”

Venerable (Cardinal) Francis Xavier Nguyễn Van Thuán

(Imprisoned by the Vietnamese government for thirteen years)

“A Christian worthy of the name is one who imitates Jesus’ life in *every* circumstance of his or her own life. “The life of every saint brings to light some particular mystery of Jesus’ life: His childhood, His preaching, His love for children, His passion, etc. The Virgin Mary lived all the mysteries in their perfection.

“The first Christians had an original way of expressing their identity:

The Christian is one who bears Jesus
in his or her mind,
in his or her heart,
in his or her gaze,
in his or her hands,
on his or her lips,
in his or her entire being.”

“I Desire Mercy”

Servant of God Chiara Lubich

(Founder and President of the Focolare movement)

“Putting up with annoying people: This too is a work of mercy, and we don’t always recognize it as such.

“Living side by side, we Christians certainly try to love one another according to Jesus’ example and commandment. But despite everyone’s good will, occasionally people with very different personalities end up living together. Thus it is comforting to know that to put up with others is a work of mercy: to endure their behavior, their awkward manner, their nagging; basically to lovingly disregard what are really minor shortcomings. Similar to feeding the hungry and visiting the sick, this is one of the works that will be asked of us at our final examination.”
